## CLIENT NEED

The Purchasing and Contracting office located at Camp Eggers, Kabul, Afghanistan required a highly-skilled, multi-talented workforce to fulfill its requirement for an audio visual (AV) system. The schedule for this activity was driven by a highly publicized communications commissioning ceremony which was attended by Afghanistan's President Karzai. In addition to a very tight schedule, DasNet personnel were required to work inside the building as it was being constructed.

## SOLUTION

At the onset of the project, the command center consisted of outdated audio/visual assets that were improperly functioning and inadequate for providing mission critical data to the military.

Upon contract award, DasNet promptly mobilized its in-country and stateside resources to develop and configure a solution capable of meeting the rigorous needs of the customer.

- DasNet provided the equipment acquisition, on-site construction and continued maintenance of the hardware and software systems that comprises one of the most effective and efficient audio/visual operational assets currently supporting the ANA National Military Command Center (NMCC) mission to-date.
- DasNet conducted integration and testing and provided custom furniture for each work module. The work modules supported laptops with webcams, microphones, wireless audio, Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) telephones, data and voice drop connections, translator audio positions, switch boxes, and Radio Frequency (RF) radio interfacing.
- DasNet skilled engineers integrated eight high resolution 60-inch display panels powered by a video processor. Additionally installed, decoder units, small computer system interface (SCSI) drives, Gigabyte (GB) memory upgrades, and other circuit packs. For backup capability, and additional day-to-day displays, two external programmed data processor's (PDPs) were installed. DasNet provided a video display array which allows the client to stretch and manipulate images across multiple display screens with a near seamless view.

## RESULT

On September 15, 2006, the commissioning ceremony was held as planned, on-schedule and uninterrupted. President Karzai was able to use the Video Teleconferencing (VTC) system to communicate with his regional government, ANA personnel, and other agencies. As a result, each entity was impressed with the performance and professionalism of the work carried out by DasNet
