CLIENT NEED

The United States Air Force (USAF) needed support for its information systems in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) including 21 operating locations in Saudi Arabia with almost 400 users and 700 Information Technology (IT) devices, as well as the various supporting US Government agencies within the Continental United States (CONUS). The selected provider would need to provide an integrated support solution that needed to address multiple functional areas: engineering, data management, configuration management, test and evaluation, database design and support, communication support, familiarization requirements and other requirements identified by the USAF.

SOLUTION

- **DasNet developed**, installed and is currently maintaining and managing the Saudi Peace Program Network (SPPN). This communications infrastructure provides a secure networked computing environment that strictly adheres to all Air Force Material Command and Department of Defense (DoD) network security practices, policies, and procedures. We support all Non-Secure Internet Protocol Router Network (NIPRNET) information system requirements in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA).
- DasNet provides support services that include engineering, management, maintenance, and administration of satellite links to/from the United States, microwave links, Definity based voice networks, and DoD-approved wireless networks, Local/Wide Area Networks (LANs/WANs), information assurance, network security, hardware and software support and integration into global wide area networks and operation and maintenance support of all system related hardware, acquisition support for hardware and software, asset management, data repository support, service/help desk operation and provisioning, technical support at the individual workstation level, and software application instruction, implementation, maintenance and training.
- In support of the USAF's mission in KSA, DasNet continues to add value to SPPN, providing Engineering and Technical Assistance (SETA) to assist in defining new requirements, evaluating new hardware and software, providing recommendations and estimated costs and performing system migrations to incorporate approved new technologies.

RESULT

In 2007, DasNet achieved certification of SPPN in accordance with the USAF/DoD standards, and works to maintain that certification. The DasNet team in KSA, backed up by CONUS based personnel have been highly effective at managing this program and moving the network forward from a bridged network to an IP based network. The Government is experiencing tremendous cost savings and has amended the contract to increase services. All objectives are consistently being met or exceeded without delays or program interruptions and are under budget.
